### PACKING CHECKLIST

NOTE: The average high temperature in New York City in late July / early August is 84 degrees and the low is 69 degrees. We will be walking outside for periods of time. Pack to dress accordingly!

- One personal bag such as a large purse or backpack that you can carry on the airplane (liquids, gels, aerosols, toothpaste, etc.) must be no more than 3.4 ounces.
- One suitcase to “check” that will go underneath the airplane with all of your clothes and toiletries (it must weigh under 50 lbs) **OR** one suitcase to carry on the plane with all of your clothes and toiletries that no more than 9 inches x 14 inches x 22 inches (22 cm x 35 cm x 56 cm) (All liquids in carry on must be 3.4 ounces or less).
- Appropriate attire for each day of the program (see below for more detailed information)
- Pens/pencils and a notepad or iPad
- For students who will be 18 years old at the time of travel: valid driver’s license or learner’s permit
